LPD Report – Capt. Martin Fehringer

- Total crimes 18 including 10 larcenies from autos nearly all in one night arrested 2 kids (16 and 14) one lives right in the neighborhood. Again, 1 bad night accounted for most of the numbers – otherwise a good month for the summer – would still like to see some improvement. Focus has shifted from O Street to school vicinities, w/start of school year.
 - ✓ Note to self don't be on juvenile probation w/an ankle bracelet
 - ✓ Way too many of these lately throughout Lincoln (SE, NE, both sides of 48th Street a couple of different groups/individuals one is 16 trying to determine what his involvement is)
 - All were unlocked 1 locked, but a PU bed billfolds, cash, shoes, clothes in a gym bag, wireless ear buds, etc. crimes
 of opportunity
- 5 others 3 shoplifts iPhone bike from bike rack apartments @ 47^{th} cut the lock and took it as well
- 7 vandalisms windows shattered GPS should show if they were involved
- 1 auto theft hit & run accident plate number 2015 Silverado unlocked w/keys likely not a true auto theft
- 2 sexual assaults both known to the individuals (husband, boyfriend)
- Sergeant retired radio system manager for the City 9/15 they will be at full strength
- Marty will provide article for upcoming newsletter

Tree Project Update – Richard Sutton

- 2013 volunteers planted 60 trees in first round most are still alive
- 2018 was the last round at Richard's request, individuals were asked to contact/set up meeting/site check/delivered trees –
 problem was limitations in the spring would like to get everyone lined up in the fall for spring delivery will have more control
 over spring species diversity
- Attractive possibility would be to get people to come to the annual meeting (3 after the ECCO blast) would like to include in the newsletter / if you have a spot come and we can do selection. \$1,100 from garden tour = 8-10 trees bag-grown, mostly native trees inexpensive, grow quickly, high survival rate. Set up a table for the Annual Meeting first come, first serve. Target North 40th Street from Vine to Holdrege setting up an appointment is difficult a lot of planting area along 40th and Vine for them. Commercial area south of MoPac between 46th & 48th Stanley et al contacting them to organize the businesses to do their own tree planting. Perhaps contact Jane Raybouldt facilitate and line up trees. Works best if people plant tree themselves perhaps we can help the businesses?
- Q: Idylwild a few dead ones noted that proposal was provided some time ago to have Robert Bienhoff maintain ECCO Blvd. + parks no answer
 - A: Parks Dept. in charge Valentino's has provided \$60k in escrow for care of Blvd. and park for 15 years
- Q: What about Lower NRD? Chelsea Johnson offered some trees not sure they are the size we need too small?
- A: Sticky wicket from 2013 City has their own specifications RE rights-of-way
 - Wish City Council would get on top of the tree planting and allocate the proper money very frustrated!!
 - ✓ Ashes are already coming down it's starting to hit we need to be ready!
 - ✓ Would like to see our fundraising be an annual event include donations from ECCO businesses?
 - ✓ What about Realtors selling properties in the neighborhood? People are more amenable when someone is new to the neighborhood to promote it
- Getting good survival bracing for removal when the Ashes start coming down P. Johnson to forward info from NRD to Richard
 ✓ Had matching grant money also, that might be available we can ask......

 - ✓ Games, hot apple cider bar, both for the Tree Project, Screening for Depression, etc., Fire Truck
