Representatives of the City of Lincoln Legal Department to discuss **proposed changes to neighborhood parking ordinances**.



- Keep your vacation dates off social media. This includes photos!
- Use timers on your interior lights.
- Lock all doors and windows, including the garage doors.
- Utilize blinds and curtains.
- Install outside motion-sensored lights.

- Stop your mail at the post office.
- Never leave any items of value in plain sight in your car and keep the doors locked.
- Get a reliable security system installed.
- Call LPD at the non-emergency number (402-441-6000) if you see someone or something that doesn't look right. We will come and investigate it. If it is nothing, that is OK. It is better to be safe than sorry. If the potential crime is in progress call 911.
