Eric's Weather Update

ECCO Vice President Eric Hunt, Climate Extension Educator at UNL

As of May 24th, we have received 7.63" of precipitation in the water year (since October 1st) according to my CoCoRAHS gauge. This amount is below normal and we have been acutely below normal since mid-March. Lancaster County is in extreme drought. It seems everyone has been invited to a "rain party" lately except us. We may start to see some improvement this summer but given the local hydrological situation, water restrictions could be in place by the 4th of July if the dryness persists. It is my strongest recommendation that grass be mowed at the highest possible setting to preserve moisture and help build deeper roots. Please also restrict lawn watering to the early morning hours on days with light winds as we move into summer to optimize irrigation. ■
